

MACRO

- U.S. equities finished mostly higher on Tuesday led by Disney and Facebook.
- The DJIA ended flat at 27,691.49 points, the S&P 500 gained +0.16% to 3.091.84 points and the Nasdaq Composite firmed +0.26% to 8,486.09 points.
- The S& P 500 touched an intraday record of 3,102.61 points, while the Nasdaq Composite booked both and intraday record and a closing record high.
- European shares ended higher to see the Eurostoxx 600 gain +0.38% to 406.90 points, the German Dax end +0.65% higher at 13,283.51 points and in London the FTSE 100 climbed +0.50% to 7,365.44 points
- The greenback added +0.13%, flat against the safe-haven Japanese yen and firmer relative to the euro (EUR/USD -0.23%).
- U.S. treasury yields ended little changed after paring early session gains. The two-year finished at 1.652% and the 10-year ended at 1.912%

PRECIOUS

- Gold once again moved underneath USD \$1,450 overnight, however was able pare declines late in trade.
- The yellow metal touched a USD \$1,445.70 low in New York, however rallied with treasury yields into the close to end just underneath USD \$1,460.
- The metal remains rangebound in lieu of trade headlines.
- Silver finished flat on the session after breaking to a USD \$16.65 low, finding interest late in trade.
- Platinum declined -0.8% to move further away from the USD \$900 handle.
- Palladium pivoted back above USD \$1,700 and finished the session on the figure.
