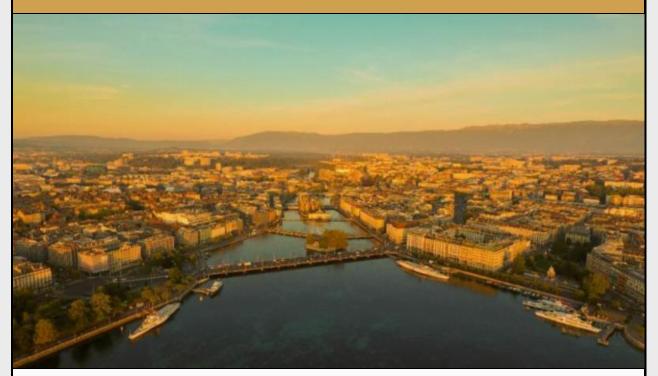

MACRO

- US equities gave back early gains in a volatile session.
- The Dow lost 208.64 points to 25,871.46, the S&P 500 fell 17.60 points to 3,097.74, while the Nasdaq edged higher 3.07 points to 9,946.12.
- Losses for utilities (-3.10%) and energy (-1.67%) led a near broad decline in the markets.
- The VIX gauge rose 6.62% to 35.12.
- The US dollar index firmed 0.17% to 97.62, the EUR traded down to 1.1176, while USD/JPY was at 106.83.
- US treasury yields were lower, the 2 year yield eased 0.6 bps to 0.186% while the 10 year yield slipped 0.8 bps to 0.694%.
- European shares were higher, the EuroSTOXX added 0.56%, the German DAX rose 0.40%, while the UK FTSE gained 1.10%.
- Oil prices were higher, Brent advanced 0.6% to \$42.19 while WTI put on 1.3% to \$39.75.
- Base metals were mixed, with zinc (+1.5%) the best performer.

PRECIOUS

- Strong session for the precious as safe-haven buying ramps up.
- Gold was bid in Asia, trading up to \$1733.
- The metal traded sideways through the London AM session as European equities gained ground.
- NY opened on the bid and sent gold to the \$1744 high before lunchtime.
- The yellow metal consolidated above \$1740 for the remainder of the session.
- Silver peaked at \$17.79 before pulling back to \$17.67 at the close.
- Platinum couldn't hang on to the NY gains but still closed above \$800.
- The Philadelphia gold and silver index rose 3.71% to 116.75.
