## **MACRO**

- US equities were mostly higher ahead of the mid-term elections.
- The Dow added 190.87 points to 25,461.70, the S&P 500 rose 15.25 points to 2,738.31, while the Nasdaq slipped 28.14 points to 7,328.85.
- There were wins for REITs (+1.69%) and energy (+1.61%) while communications (-0.32%) led the laggards.
- The VIX gauge added 0.43% to 19.90.
- The US dollar index eased 0.14% to 96.308, the EUR traded up to 1.1421, while USD/JPY was as low as 113.09.
- US treasury yields were mixed, the 2 year yield added 1.2 bps to 2.908% while the 10 year yield slipped 0.6 bps to 3.199%.
- European shares were mostly lower, the EuroSTOXX lost 0.16%, the German DAX fell 0.21%, while the UK FTSE gained 0.14%.
- Oil prices were higher, Brent firmed 0.6% to \$72.83 while WTI added 0.3% to \$62.86.
- Base metals were mostly lower, with copper (-1.5%) leading the losses.
- In US economic data, the ISM non-manufacturing index fell to 60.3 in October from 61.6 in September.

## **PRECIOUS**

- Gold posted a session high \$1234 in early Asian trading before drifting to \$1230 with USD/CNH bid.
- The SGE premium was around \$5-6 over loco London.
- There was a bump up to the opening levels during London AM before a sharp sell off into the NY open.
- The metal printed a low of \$1227 in early NY trading followed by a rebound back to \$1233.
- The yellow metal finished the day slightly lower at \$1230.
- Silver closed lower at \$14.60.
- Palladium surged 2% off the low to end up at 1,133.
- The Philadelphia gold and silver index added 0.40%.
- SPDR Gold Trust holdings down 0.23% to 757.29mt.
