MACRO

- US equities recovered late in the session after an early sell off to finish in the black.
- The Dow Jones rose 162.94 points, the S&P500 climbed 19.86 points whilst the Nasdaq gained 49.772 points.
- European shares were softer. The Euro STOXX eased 0.3%, the German Dax fell 0.1% whilst the UK FTSE declined 0.4%.
- The VIX gauge lost 4.3% to 18.23.
- US treasury yields were higher. The 2 year yield gained 3.7 bps to 2.566% whilst the 10 year yield rose 3.2 bps to 2.745%.
- Oil prices were higher. WTI rose 0.4% to \$52.23 whilst Brent gained 0.4% to \$61.29.
- Base metals were mixed. Nickel fell 0.3% whilst copper gained 0.4%.
- The CRB index rose 0.1% to 179.76.
- The Fed Phili index rebounded over 30% of manufacturers reported an increase in production.

PRECIOUS

- Gold continues to trade the 1285-1295 range.
- Palladium touches another all time high trading through 1400.
- Asia were on the offer pressuring the yellow metal down to 1291.
- Europe were happy to buy the dip pushing the yellow metal back up to 1295 but heavy offers at this level capped the market.
- NY were light offers selling XAU sub 1290.
- Silver came under heavy long liquidation, trading down to a low of 15.46.
- Palladium was again the star performer. It has now rallied around \$120 this week alone!
- The Philadelphia gold and silver index declined 0.01%.
- The SPDR gold trust holdings were unchanged at 797.71 metric tons.

- Asian equities open higher following Wall Street's lead.
