MACRO

- US equities finished lower on Friday after a late sell off.
- The Dow lost 98.68 points to 25,764.00, the S&P 500 fell 16.79 points to 2,859.53, while the Nasdaq gave up 81.76 points to 7,816.280.
- Industrials (-1.10%) and energy (-1.05%) led a near broad decline in the markets.
- The VIX gauge added 4.4% to 16.
- The US dollar index firmed 0.19% to 98.02, the EUR traded down to 1.1155, while USD/JPY was as high as 110.12.
- US treasury yields were higher, the 2 year yield rose 2.3 bps to 2.198% while the 10 year yield gained 1.2 bps to 2.391%.
- European shares were lower, the EuroSTOXX shed 0.36%, the German DAX declined 0.58%, while the UK FTSE sold off 0.22%.
- Oil prices were lower, Brent slipped 0.5% to \$72.21 while WTI fell 0.3% to \$62.76.
- Base metals were broadly lower, with zinc (-1.4%) leading the losses.
- In US economic data, the consumer confidence index rose to a 15 year high 102.4 in May.
- The Conference Board's leading index rose 0.2% to 112.1 in May.

PRECIOUS

- Consecutive soft sessions for the precious as gold falls to a 2 week low.
- Gold was quiet through Asian hours with the SGE premium at \$3-4.
- High of \$1288 came just ahead of the London open before retracing to opening levels during the AM session.
- NY were on the offer from the opening bell as the greenback found support.
- The yellow metal posted a 2 week low \$1274 before finishing the week at \$1277.
- Silver closed right around the low at \$14.39.
- PGMs closed at the lows.
- The Philadelphia gold and silver index rose 0.09%.
- SPDR Gold Trust holdings increased 0.40% to 736.17mt.
