MACRO

- US equities continued to slide as the tech sector dragged markets lower.
- The Dow lost 84.10 points to 25,679.90, the S&P 500 fell 19.30 points to 2,840.23, while the Nasdaq gave up 113.91 points to 7,702.380.
- Losses in tech (-1.75%), REITs (-1.62%) and materials (-1.46%) led markets lower.
- The VIX gauge rose 2.2% to 16.
- The US dollar index eased 0.09% to 97.93, the EUR was up at 1.1173, while USD/JPY traded down to 109.87.
- US treasury yields were higher, the 2 year yield rose 0.8 bps to 2.221% while the 10 year yield gained 1.8 bps to 2.418%.
- European shares were lower, the EuroSTOXX shed 1.06%, the German DAX declined 1.61%, while the UK FTSE sold off 0.51%.
- Oil prices were lower, Brent fell 1.4% to \$72.07 while WTI slipped 0.6% to \$63.16.
- In US economic data, the Chicago Fed national activity index fell to -0.45 in April from 0.05 in March.

PRECIOUS

- Quiet session for the precious as gold remains within a tight \$5 range.
- Gold drifted slowly lower through Asian hours with the SGE premium back up at \$7-8.
- The day's low of \$1273 was printed during the London AM session.
- Some support in early NY trading saw the metal post the session high \$1278.80.
- The yellow metal finished the day at the opening level \$1277.
- Silver ended up marginally higher at \$14.45.
- Palladium was the standout, picking up \$20 to close at \$1232.
- The Philadelphia gold and silver index eased 0.36%.
- SPDR Gold trust holdings unchanged at 736.17mt.
