Ranges: Europe/US Markets:

MACRO:

- US equities were hammered on Friday on the back of ongoing concerns surrounding the trade tensions between China and the US.

- The Dow Jones slumped 572.46 points, the S&P500 dumped 58.37 points whilst the Nasdaq fell 161.44 points.

- The best performing sector was utilities (-0.71%) whilst the worst was industrials (-2.73%).

- European shares were lower. The Euro STOXX fell 0.6%, the German Dax eased 0.5% whilst the UK FTSE retreated 0.2%.

- The VIX gauge jumped 13.446% to 21.49.

- The dollar index fell 0.39% to 90.108.

- Oil prices were softer. WTI fell 1.6% to \$62.06 whilst Brent dropped 1.1% to \$67.11.

- Base metals were mixed. Aluminium rose 1.7% whilst copper fell 0.7%.

- The CRB index fell 0.8% to 192.25.

- US treasury yields were lower. The 2 year bond fell 2 bps to 2.266% whilst the 10 year yield fell 3.8 bps to 2.774%.

- US NFP's were lower than expected (+103k vs +185k expected) but wages increased.

PRECIOUS:

- A choppy session for the precious with gold trading in a \$15 range.

- Early in the session a headline stating that Trump is considering a \$100 billion in additional China tariffs gave the yellow metal a bid pushing the market up to 1332.

- After touching 1332.50, XAU began to turn lower giving up around \$7 prior to London open.

- A weaker than expected NFP sent the yellow metal higher touching a high of 1335.25 before finishing the session at 1333.50.

- Silver also traded higher touching a peak of 16.485.

- The Philadelphia gold and silver index gained 0.09%.

- Platinum held support at 900 closing towards the highs at 915.
